STEP 2 COLLAGE

At The Convention in Florida, Jim and I lead a workshop on the Step 2 collage. The morning of that workshop we were having our quiet time: prayer, 10th step check-in and reading. The reading is usually a topic from the "Blue Book" or Reflections, however on this morning we decided to look at step 2 and specifically the "collage". As my partner was sharing, I realized that he was sharing with me some very specific ways to accomplish this wonderful tool of Step 2. I asked him to repeat it and I wrote it down. We used it in the workshop with what seemed like great success, based on what those who took the workshop had to say. So we offer this to the RCA community to take what you can use and leave the rest. Yours in Service to RCA.

1. A Silent Gathering (no talking): Cut out, spend 1/2hr each choosing their own pictures that remind them of their own HP and remind themselves of the coupleship HP.
2. 1/2 Hour Share with your partner, sitting face to face why you chose each Picture or Word or Phrase
3. 1/2 hour Collaborate which pictures or phrase or words go in coupleship pile.
4. 1/2 hour Create the image place them on the paper and collaborate on where you want them to be on the collage.
5. Look at the finished product, share thoughts and feelings, Put in prominent place in home and share it at a meeting of RCA

1/2 hr at a time keeps the coupleship in the present. Scheduling more 1/2 hours times for working on any particular part may be needed.

Recovering Couples Anonymous World Service Organization Board of Trustee Positions are filled each year at the Annual Business Meeting. These meetings are held during the weekend of the Annual Convention. These meetings are open to all RCA members. Our Bylaws state that a couple is qualified for Board Service if they meet this criteria: "Any couple which is a member of a Member Group and which professes that they have been actively working the twelve steps of R.C.A. for 12 months shall be qualified to be nominated for the Board of Trustees." Experienced Board Members would suggest that couples interested in Board Service have had some experience in working on a WSO committee. Nominations are taken at the Annual meeting, with voting occurring immediately before the closing ceremony. The first meeting of the "new" Board occurs that same day. Fourth Edition History and Update

Since the printing of Third Edition of *Recovering Couples Anonymous* in 1996, our fellowship has continued to grow in recovery. The improvements in our website have made it much easier for those couples who still suffer to find RCA in their area. As with most other Twelve Step fellowships, RCA has not been without its “growing pains.” And, as pain was the great motivator that brought many of us into recovery in the first place, it can also be the motivator to encourage RCA to flourish as a healthy recovery organization -- an organization that is able to effectively carry the message of hope and recovery to couples who still suffer.

To develop a book reflecting the continuing RCA experience, and to incorporate the collective group conscience of all the member groups, a new “fourth edition” of the Blue Book has been written. It was written in draft form and presented to the RCA Membership just before the 2005 Convention for general distribution. Questionnaires were included with the draft copies and a website organized with questions. Both the questionnaires and the website were used to obtain feedback from the RCA membership as to how the fourth edition reflected the experience, strength, and hope of the membership. The data were collected and used to modify the first draft. This process was repeated in 2006. At the 2007 Annual Business meeting a motion was passed which would give the Fellowship a “90-day review” of this draft. Since the 2007 Convention, the Literature Committee has extensively modified the 2006 draft based on the second round of comments from the member groups. The final review by the Fellowship is imminent.

Each Active RCA group will automatically receive an electronic read-only copy by e-mail. The Outreach Committee members will be calling each Group Contact Couple listed in the RCA directory to get a valid email address. Some groups might prefer to receive a printed review copy by postal mail. If so, a donation will be requested to offset the cost of printing and mailing. The GCC's will be polling their groups to determine if their group would like to receive the printed review copy in addition to the electronic copy, and getting valid postal addresses for this purpose. Hopefully, these options will insure a wider access to the Fellowship and allow all members to take part in the process of review and decision. Outreach will be obtaining postal and email addresses through mid-March of this year. By early April, the “90-day review” will begin and the fellowship will have the opportunity to reach a decision about this draft of the Fourth Edition.

A simple ballot giving each group the opportunity to vote (yes, no, or abstain) will be provided during the 90-day review process. If approved by a two-thirds majority of **those voting yes or no**, it will be the first time RCA will have a **Fellowship** approved Blue Book. We hope to be taking orders at the 2010 Convention in Niagara Falls.
